



Assisted Re-Homing

What is assisted re-homing?

Assisted re-homing means we will help you to find a new and suitable home for your dog. We do this by advertising your dog on our social media platforms.

Minimum requirements of your dog

To be able to do this your dog must be:

- Microchipped (we need the number)
- Desexed

We cannot rehome dogs that have a history of being dangerous or aggressive.

The process

You [write up a profile](#) for your dog. Be honest! Give them the best chance of finding a successful home. You can see some successful [examples](#) at the end of this sheet you can copy from. Once you have written a profile and have a selection of good pictures send them to us on Messenger

It is up to you to screen people for your dog. We suggest that you initially ask people to text you first and if you like the sound of them, you can email or text them our screening questions which are a good guide (see [example screening questions](#)).

After this, if you still feel confident you would do a 'meet and greet'. You are under no obligation to give them your dog if it doesn't feel right and simply say "you're meeting another candidate and will let them know afterwards."

If it's a match and you are happy with the outcome you and the new owners complete a transfer of ownership form to make it complete. You can find that here:

It is your responsibility as the 'old' owner to submit the completed form to a council within 14 days of handover.

Creating a profile

Pictures

The pictures are very important and help attract your dog a wide audience. Try and take lots and where your dog looks their best! And shows the different sides of their personality 😊

What information to include in the profile

Start with the basic information...

Screening questions

- Are you an Australian resident?
- What are your usual (not during COVID-19 pandemic) work hours and those of other people in the home? *Please provide hours per week.*
- In which suburb are you located?
- Number of family members in the home?
- Ages of children?
- Ages of adults in the home?
- Are you residing in a house or an apartment?
- Do you own or rent please? *If renting please provide evidence of landlord/ strata (both if an apartment) permission to have a dog living inside at premises.*
- Where would dog/puppy sleep?
- Do you have other pets in the home? *Please list.*
- If you have dogs, are they desexed vaccinated and chipped? *Please provide evidence.*
- What do you (or plan to) feed your dogs?
- How often would your dogs be washed/groomed/nails trimmed etc?
- Do you have a vet and how often do your pets go to the vet?
- Are your fences and gates secure without gaps? Are they high enough for a bigger dog not to jump over?
- Is your pool secure? *Pool fencing may have gaps which a small pup or dog can climb through.*
- What is the size of your land and yard?
- Will your dog be socialised and walked? *Please describe.*
- Do you have dog experience? *Please describe.*
- Please send some photos of your home and yard. *Please attach.*
- Anything else you would like to tell us?
